Description

A Field Service Technician is responsible for providing service and customer support during field visits or dispatches. This individual must be able to apply mechanical knowledge to build and install water treatment systems according to engineering specifications and design.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in site installation of AV filtration systems, GAC/media services, ductile iron pipe, stainless steel pipe site layout and planning
- Interpret blueprints, specifications, diagrams, or schematics to determine filtration installs, and pipe design install
- Process and develop as a team with Operations future Filtration builds and needs
- Comply with and drive all safety requirements and protocols for working in a hazardous environment
- Gain full proficiency in one specific area of discipline
- Work under moderate to heavy supervision

Qualifications:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be professional, proactive, and positive. Having a passion for exceptional customer service and support is a must. Being sensitive to the unpredictable demands and uncertainties associated with customer service is a requisite to delivering superior results and exceeding the expectations of very demanding customers.
